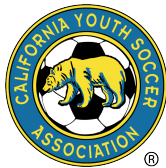

CENTRAL VALLEY FUEGO CUP TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Tournament Registration Deadline: Friday November 11, 2011

1. Tournament Check-in is on Friday November 25, 2011 from 6pm-9pm at California Odyssey Soccer Club Office located at 435 N. Clovis Ave. #103 Clovis, CA 93611. Teams unable to make check-in **must** contact Tournament Director for approval.
2. This is a US Club sanctioned event however you may compete if you are a CYSA team by filling out the CYSA form 2651 and submitting to kkillion@cysanorth.org
 - **For any CYSA team traveling to tournament, jamboree, festival that has been sanctioned by an organization that is not a member of US Youth Soccer but is an affiliated member of US Soccer Federation (i.e. AYSO, US Club Soccer, SAY, etc.), a registered team official team for the CYSA team must submit this notification form to the CYSA Office no later than five business days prior to traveling to the tournament. A team's failure to properly notify CYSA in accordance with the established protocol could delay and/or invalidate payment on any insurance claims for the player and/or team arising from participation in the games to which the team traveled.**
3. All teams are required to present an approved US Club or USYS roster at Tournament Check-in. Please keep a copy of an approved roster with you at all times.
4. You may have up to five (5) guest players on a roster.
5. All players must wear shin guards.
6. Teams are required to be at field at least 30 MINUTES prior to the scheduled start of each game.
7. The HOME TEAM is listed first on the schedule and gets choice of sideline.
8. All games are final as determined by game referee. **NO PROTESTS ARE ALLOWED.** The Tournament Director shall address any questions that cannot be answered at the field with his tournament committee. Tournament Director decisions are FINAL.

PROHIBITIONS

The following are prohibited at any of the tournament game sites:

- Possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances
- DOGS
- Use of tobacco products-
Use of tobacco products on the grounds of any public school facility is a violation of California State Law.
- Fire Arms

Referees are instructed to abandon a game if any person affiliated with a team refuses to comply with the prohibitions listed above. Thank you for your cooperation.

INJURIES

Any injuries must be reported to a tournament official so that an injury report can be completed.

WEATHER

If deemed necessary by the tournament committee, games may be shortened, go to FIFA penalty kicks or be cancelled due to extreme weather or field conditions

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The tournament committee reserves the right to establish policy as deemed necessary in regard to problems and/or circumstances not specifically addressed. The final decision of the tournament director and committee is not subject to appeal.

Ejections

Any player, coach or team official shown a red card will automatically be suspended for the remainder of that game and will not be allowed to play or coach in the next game. Tournament Committee may impose additional suspension on a case-by-case basis.

7 v 7: 6 field players, 1 goalkeeper
Game Length: 20-minute halves with 5 minute halftime

Flow of Game:

- A. Substitution- FIFA Rules, any stoppage, referee approval
- B. Game Start- Ball at midfield, opposing team must be outside of center circle when kick is taken.
- C. Free Kicks- FIFA Rules, 10 yards distance by opponent
- D. Slide Tackling- Prohibited and considered dangerous play.
